Rehearsals start on Monday with the show on Friday late afternoon- (some years we do two performances to allow for the audience size one at 3pm and one at 5pm)

With Costumes, Lights, Make up and lots of sparkle there are acting, singing and dancing parts for all ages and abilities.

The musical is specially adapted for all the children who are taking part to make sure everyone has a super time, makes friends and increase their confidence through performance!

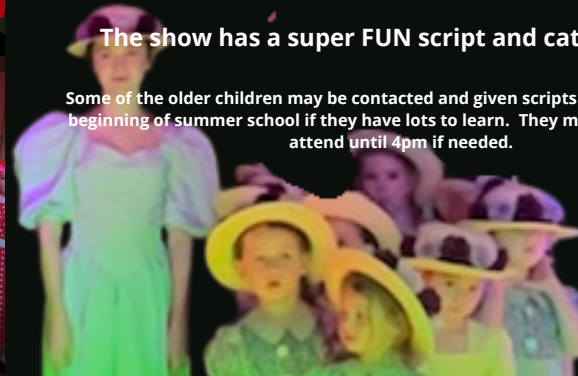
Our Summer School not just for our WATA students and their siblings and friends - children from the wider community are **MORE** than welcome!

Rehearsals take place each day at 10am until 3pm From Monday to Thursday.

On Friday everyone arrives at 10am and stays until the shows with a /sausage/fish and chip party in the park in between

Some of the older children may be contacted and given scripts to learn before the beginning of summer school if they have lots to learn. They may also be asked to attend until 4pm if needed.

The show will be directed by Penelope Lambert (Miss Penny) Assisted by The WATA team of professional teachers some have just returned from their recent tours in the world of theatre! Miss Katie Peters & Beth Hancock both with MA in Drama & Musical Theatre

All our staff have CRB checks, basic First Aid, Health and Safety & Child Protection training with our WATA team.

All our Senior Teachers are fully qualified & professional teachers. Our assistants are all TA in state schools and others are Senior or X-Students of WATA who have returned for the summer from their respective universities and Drama Schools.

TIMETABLE

We begin each day with drama and friendship building games and exercises bringing our full cast together with lots of Fun!

During the morning we rehearse as a full cast and in smaller groups to learn the scenes and lines and then we all meet for a snack break.

LUNCH

We will have a fully supervised picnic lunch (weather permitting) each day every younger student will be given an older student to sit with and look after them every day.

WE will then have some team fun games too.

During the afternoon .. After going through our songs and learning the dances, The younger children will do an activity while the older students continue to rehearse.

On Friday we have our Dress rehearsal and then a big Sausage/Fish & Chip picnic is delivered for all the cast to enjoy before the performances!

We do accept children of reception age who are not yet 5 if they are already students at WATA. All students under 5 will be accepted at the discretion of the Principal please email or call us beforehand and we will help you book.
